Abstract

It is alarming that 3.6 billion people in the world do not have access to safe sanitation. In order to raise awareness on the need to address and tackle the global sanitation problem, the United Nations observes World Toilet Day on 19th November every year. Access to safe sanitation facilities is an important prerequisite for health and hygiene, and a dignified life. Realising the importance of sanitation, Karnataka has initiated several programmes for the improvement of sanitation in rural and urban areas. Against this background, the Institute for Social and Economic Change, Bengaluru, is organising a Webinar to deliberate the issues relating to sanitation. The faculty members will present findings of their research carried out in rural and urban areas of Karnataka and the policy implications that emerge from these studies. The issues that are proposed to be covered include the access, use, safety and sustainability of individual, community and public toilets, among others.
